Thank you for your interest in Calvary Chapel Christian School. **In accordance with Arizona state law, Kindergarten applicants must be age 5 by September 1, 2009.** The attached application is for the 2009-2010 school year only. We do not have a waiting list for future years. Listed below is some basic information about our school. If you find you still have questions, please contact the school office or reference our website at www.calvarychapelchristianschool.org for more information.

Applications & Application Fee: Application fee: Application fee of \$50 per student (non-refundable). Please return initial application to the CCCS front office and your fee will be collected at that time. When your fee has been collected, a family interview will be set up, and the second application will be given. At the time of the family interview the registration fee of \$250 is due, along with the completed second application. Calvary Chapel Christian Schools admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin.

School Hours: Our Kindergarten program includes a half-day or full-day schedule. **For the half-day program,** the hours are 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon. Parents must make their own arrangements for the other half of the day. King's Kids is available from 7:00 a.m.- 8:15 a.m. **For the full-day kindergarten,** school begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 2:45 p.m. King's Kids is available from 7:00 a.m.-8:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m.-5:30 p.m.

School Year: We have a traditional school year, August-May.

Tuition: Tuition for the 2009/2010 school year will be: Half-day K \$3,000, Full-day K \$4,550, Grades 1-5 \$4,550, Grades 6-8 \$4,550. For those who regularly attend and support Calvary Chapel of Tucson, we will be offering a Calvary Chapel Tucson family discount of \$200 per child. Tuition is payable in 10 monthly payments due the first of the month, August through May.

Registration Fee: The yearly registration fee of \$200 per child includes student materials, curriculum, yearbook and P.E. T-shirt. \$150 is collected on the appointed registration day, and the remaining \$50 is due with the first tuition payment August 1, 2009. No paid portion of this fee is refunded.

King's Kids: Half-day kindergarten students may utilize the extended care offered Monday through Friday before school, 7:00 - 8:00 a.m., with a pledge \$3 per day, per student. Full-day kindergarten students may utilize morning care as well as our After School Program classes which include fine art, tutoring, and athletics. Cost varies according to the class, and class enrollment is limited. Registration will begin August 1, 2009

Curriculum: CCCS uses a Christian curriculum called ABEKA for phonics and reading, and Saxon for math. Kindergarten students learn to read by using this structural, sequential phonics based curriculum. They will learn to count and print numbers to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's. They will also learn addition, telling time and counting money. This curriculum stresses the fundamentals. There is no entrance testing. Weekly specials include music, art, physical education, computer and Spanish.

School Uniforms: All students are required to wear the approved uniform. The Kindergarten uniform is navy/khaki shorts/skirts/capris/pants, and navy/khaki/white polo/oxford shirt. Students may also purchase the Calvary logo shirts from the front office that may be worn. Jeans are allowed with a polo/oxford shirt on Fridays.

Discipline: The school uses a discipline system based on the book of Proverbs where students move from wise to simple to foolish to scorner. The discipline will include a warning/natural consequence/detention system for correcting behavioral problems. Repeat offenders will be sent to the Administrator for prayer, exhortation and, if necessary, suspension or expulsion from enrollment.

Spiritual Life: Kindergarten students begin school with prayer and a Bible lesson every day. The students memorize a bible verse weekly and have chapel and worship time each week. During the school day, students are encouraged to seek the Lord's will in every situation in their lives.
